- 1. Smallmouth bass fight as hard as trout. Umpqua R. in SW Oregon, float-trip, especially in remote section.
- 2. Brownlee Reservoir crappie in spring (includes decent numbers of smallmouth bass), eastern Oregon.
- 3. Big Sabin Lake rainbow trout, in the spring, when pay for two rods/person. Southern BC. \$42/rod (US). 246
- 4. Smallmouth Bass on Snake River in Idaho, Hells Canyon, above Salmon R. mouth, from a guided jet boat.
- 5. Harrison River pink salmon, in SW BC (odd # years.)
- 6. John Day River smallmouth float trip. N Oregon.
- 7. Pinks on Skeena River (Northern BC). Plus good shot at steelhead/sockeye/coho + world-class-sized chum, + worldclass-sized kings. One of best salmon rivers in the world!
- 8. Moses Lake in central Washington for big spawning perch.
- 9. Lily Lake trout, by Wenatchee, when timing-details are correct.
- 10. John Day area (N. Oregon) shad from shore.

Bonus

- 11. Bonneville Shad from a boat (+ sturgeon if desired,)
- 12. Skagit River pinks, casting JIGS, at our spot by Lyman WA.

Top 10 Biggest-fish Fishing Scenarios

1	x. averag (pounds)
1. Bonneville, targeting over-sized sturgeon using giant baits, with this guidebiggest fish in the NW! 9' is not unusual!	195
2. <i>Peak</i> scenario on the best (next to the Columbia River) sturgeon river on the West coast! Fraser River w/a guide.	67
3. A <i>spring-time</i> scenario on the best (next to the Columbia River) sturgeon river on the West Coast! Fraser River w/guide.	67
4. Skeena River system, in Northern BC, for Kings. Best <i>huge</i> King fishery in world (except Alaska)! A 50 to 70 lb. King is feasible. Guide probably best.	29.5
5. Harrison River trolling. Kings (huge!)also hook some chums/coho	28
6. Stamp/Somass River for kings (& coho) on Vancouver Island GIANT BONN. STUREON	24
7. Weekday on Chilliwack/Vedder targeting kings (but good numbers of coho, + incidental chum,) in SW BC	23
8. We almost hit the 30lb. mark with chinook near Port Alberni (saltwater)	21
9. Albacore Tuna (15-35lb.) are practically the best fighters around! Wesport charter	21
10. Columbia River sturgeon by Megler/Astoria bridge (size includes lots of small shakers)	19

These biggest-fish scenarios usually yield "only" from **8 to 30** hookups/weekend/boat (Based on Dale and his dad and brother fishing 2 days, 8 hours/day, running this system fully, including following our 12 "Catching Rules", which includes completing 4 trips there, and not just experimenting)





Top 10 Most Scenic Fishing Scenarios On Our List (In Our *Opinion*)



SNAKE RIVER SCENERY!

- 1. One day travel from Seattle: over the years, Dale's totalled hundreds of cutthroats on scenic NF Flathead River in NW Montana, float-trip...this view has been on *calendars*
- 2. Dale's brother's most aesthetically pleasing fishery! Upper Pitt River trout (bull/rainbow/cutthroat) we got were all 15" to 5 lbs. Guided
- 3. Continental US's best (?) dry-fly fishing (cutthroat trout,) on guided float trip on scenic Middle Fork of Salmon River in N. Central Idaho
- 4. Smallmouth Bass in actually the deepest gorge in North America: Snake River in Idaho, Hells Canyon, above Salmon R. mouth, from a guided jet boat...we saw Doll Sheep by the water
- 5. Dozens of Skagit River (Upper) pink salmon, above mouth of Sauk...river clarity not nearly as much a problem up that far. Fewer people, too
- 6. Float trip on St. Mary River in SE BC for cutts, one of BC's better stream trout scenarios
- 7. Clarkston Washington based steelhead trip on Snake R. near Hells Canyon (or maybe lower Clearwater River) depends on temperatures, with a guide, from a jet boat
- 8. Our best blackmouth fishing ever: edge of Barkley Sound. Some of the most beautiful islands around
- 9. Selway River, or Lochsa River Idaho cutthroat trout
- 10. Cutthroat trout at our spot on St. Joe River in N Idaho
